## I Company description

---

- ▶ During market consultation phases, to participate in initial discussions with lenders or investors, assisting to meetings and following up negotiations;
- ▶ During execution phase, monitor due diligence processes as well as the drafting of legal documentation, final negotiations, and involvement up to the closing.

As part of Finergreen's growth, you may also be required to carry out market research in order to help the company generate new activity and develop its network of clients and partners.

You may also work in collaboration with Finergreen's team on communication material related to the renewable energy sector (market studies, articles, publications, etc.).
